

# Fiscal Management

## **Funding Channel**

#### Rationale

Provide details regarding the rationale for your fiscal structure decision. How did you arrive at the decision? What were the overwhelming benefits to using this structure?

The Kern AEBG Consortium functioned under the Fiscal Agent model with the Kern Community College District functioning as the Fiscal Agent during the 2015-16 year. The fiscal structure for the 2016-17 year was brought to the consortium board for review and discussion at the March 29, 2016 board meeting. Members examined the advantages and disadvantages of both a Fiscal Agent model and a Direct Funding structure as well as the impact on small and large districts of both models. During continued discussion at the Kern AEBG Board meeting on April 13, members expressed a desire to move to a Direct Funding model with the perception that this model would "expedite" processes and procedures. Thus, by unanimous vote at the April 13th, 2016 Board meeting, the consortium elected move to a Direct Funded model for the 2016-17 year. As of the April 28, 2017 Kern AEBG Board meeting, all members agree to continue with the Direct Funded model.

### Fiscal Management Approach

Whether using a fiscal agent or direct funding model, describe how you are fiscally managing your block grant. How are you rolling up grant expenditures to report to the State?

John Means, Associate Chancellor of Economic and Workforce Development, serves as the Kern AEBG programmatic lead. The Project Director, under the direction of John Means, is responsible for the timely gathering of all member fiscal reports to be rolled up and submitted to the state. Once gathered, all submissions are delivered to Carlene Feichter, Accounting Manager, and her department for the purpose of rolling member submissions together. Carlene Feichter reports to Deborah Martin, Interim Chief Financial Officer and the consortium's certifying official. All member fiscal reports are generated by each member's district accounting team, certified, and upload to the consortium's shared drive for the purpose of rolling information together. Members are responsible for maintaining appropriate supporting documentation (i.e.: invoices, purchase orders, etc.) according to their district practices. In order to prepare for detailed reporting to the state, each member has prepared a Scope of Work identifying program expenditures by program area, object code, and program objective any and all intended to purchases for the year. This information has been submitted to the Kern AEBG Board, approved, and uploaded into an electronic database in order that all purchases may be reconciled against a consortium-approved Scope of Work plan.

During the 2016-17 allocation year, \$52,000 was made available to Muroc Joint Unified School District.

Under new leadership, the district Superintendent passionately participates in all AEBG board meetings and expressed a strong desire for support in order to reopen the adult school program that had been shuttered.

### Consensus and Approval

Describe how you arrived at consensus and approval of the allocations provided in the table above.

All Kern Consortium members submit a detailed work plan (Scope of Work) for projects they intended to develop during each allocation cycle. All work plans along with detailed budgets are submitted by each member for each allocation year to the board for approval. All projects currently in development are in alignment with the 3-Year Plan and the Annual Plans. As the board reviews and approves plans, members are cognoscenti of the funding for each project and work collaboratively to ensure that each member has adequate funding to execute plans that meet the needs of their community.

As a result of the on-going collaboration and analysis of need, the Kern Community College District requested to reallocate \$200,000 of the district allocation to fund additional work in the adult end programs. This, at the Kern AEBG board's April 28, 2017 meeting, KCCD redistributed \$200,000 of their allocation to K12 partner programs. Upon a consensus vote, the following members received additional funding: Tehachapi - \$50,000, Kern High - \$50,000, Muroc - \$100,000.
